New Email System

OmegaNet Inc. announces inauguration of an entirely new and greatly improved email system, complete with auto-reply such as out of office messages, multiple forwarding addresses, and webmail, which features an appointment calendar, address book and message search. Change in SKU order

On Manufacturer web sites, it has been possible to sort products three ways:

1. by the Item Name,
2. by the SKU (lowest to highest number), and
3. by custom numbering ([more info](#)).

Recently it was decided that enough of our clients would prefer SKU sorting to be descending (highest to lowest numbers) instead of ascending order, we have changed the default to descending. If you prefer ascending, you can still do it, but you'll need to notify OmegaNet (gary@omeganetinc.net or 770-482-9705).

This does not affect the other two sorting methods.
